

Zenlay 241

Epoxy Resin Adhesive Putty

Zenlay 241 is a general purpose epoxy resin adhesive putty. It is solvent free and of medium to high reactivity for use at temperatures above 10 °C.

Mixing and Application:

Resin and hardener are mixed in equal parts by volume with a stiff spatula or putty knife until uniform in colour and free of streaks.

Method of Application & Uses:

Zenlay 241 should be applied by a stiff spatula, paint scraper or putty knife. Surfaces to receive Zenlay 241 should preferably be cleaned and dry. Final smoothing off can be achieved with a wet finger or tool, or by using a thin polythene sheet.

Some Uses Include:

- Patching holes in horizontal and nonhorizontal surfaces such as concrete, wood, bricks, metal, precast units, etc.
- General purpose non-structural adhesive, e.g. adhering concrete, ceramics, metal, asbestos, timber, masonry, etc. and where heavy loads are not a factor.
- Filling of non-moving cracks in concrete, wood and steel.
- Repairing rounded edges or paving stones, etc.

Mixing Ratio: 1:1 by volume

• Usable life: ± 45 min at 20 °C

• Setting time: ± 5 hrs at 20 °C

 Compressive strength after 7 days at 20 °C: 60MPa

 Tensile strength after 7 days at 20 °C: 11MPa

Shrinkage: NegligibleColour: Grey Cement

Storage:

Zenlay 241 should be stored in a cool dry place, preferably in its original container.
